Walk-off Winner In a thrilling, back-and-torth
contest, Adrian Santana belted a walk-off grand slam
in the bottom of the ninth to lift Bowling Green to a
7-3 win over the Hub City Spartanburgers on Tues-
day night. In his first game back with the Hot Rods in
five weeks, Ryan Spikes fell a triple short of the cycle.
Right-hander Garrett Edwards posted another strong
outing, allowing just one run with five punchouts and
no walks across 6.0 innings.

Race for First.... With the first half of the season coming to a close on Thursday, the Hot Rods are looking to lock up a first-half title and a playoff spot for the eighth time in nine seasons. Their magic number stands at one as they lead the Greenville Drive by a 0.5 game in the South Atlantic League South. Either a Hot Rods win or a Drive loss in either of the clubs' next two contests would clinch the first-half title for Bowling Green.

Adrian Slam-tana!... Adrian Santana played hero on Tuesday night, smashing his first career grand slam and second career home run. The Rays No. 18 prospect has reached base in 19 consecutive games. Over that span, Santana is 28 for 77 (.364), with four doubles, one homer, 17 RBIs, and 10 walks compared to just seven strikeouts. This is the second-longest on-base streak this season for a Hot Rods hitter, trailing only Emilien Pitre, who reached base in 32 consecutive games from April 11 to May 21.

E Stands for Excellent.... As the race for a firsthalf title heats up, so has Emilien Pitre. Over his last eight games, Tampa Bay's No. 22 prospect is 16 for 35 (.457) with 12 RBIs. This includes a three-game stretch in which he went 10 for 14 (.714) with eight RBIs.

Dynasty in Bowling Green.... Last Saturday's win over Winston-Salem clinched Bowling Green's 12th consecutive over .500 half dating back to 2017. The Hot Rods own an over .600 winning percentage and have captured six league titles during that span.

Gill Hill Takes the Hill... Bowling Green sends Gary Gill Hill to the bump for Wednesday's contest. The right-hander, who entered the series ranked fourth completed 5.0 innings in 10 of his last 11 starts. Gill Hill has recorded a 2.53 ERA through two starts in lune


