Double Trouble.... The Hot Rods dropped both games of Saturday's doubleheader to the Jersey Shore BlueClaws, falling 4-2 in eight innings in game one followed by an 8-2 loss in the nightcap of the twin bill. It is the first time Bowling Green dropped both games of a doubleheader at home since June of 2017, when they were members of the Midwest League. Carlos Colmenarez launched his first High-A homer to tie game one at 1-1 followed by Daniel Vellojin's game-tying RBI single in the sixth inning. Gary Gill Hill recorded a season-high eight punchouts and allowed just two runs on three hits across 5.2 innings. In game two, Ryan Cermak launched his second homer of the series, a game-tying solo blast in the second. He followed up with an RBI single in the third to briefly to give Bowling Green the lead.

Cermak Crushes 'Claws... Ryan Cermak continues to terrorize Jersey Shore pitching this series. The outfielder accounted for Bowling Green's only two runs in game two on Saturday, smashing a game-tying solo home run and collecting a go-ahead RBI single the following inning. He is 5-for-17 (.294) with two homers, six RBIs and has tallied a .647 slugging percentage across all five games this series. He crushed Bowling Green's first walk-off homer of the season on Thursday night, a two-run, ninth inning blast to lift the Bootleggers to a 5-4 victory.

O-Canada.... One of three Canadians on the Hot Rods roster, Noah Myers continues his tear at the High-A level. Entering Sunday's series finale against Jersey Shore, Myers ranks sixth among all full-season Minor League players with a .453 on-base percentage. He is tied for second in the South Atlantic League in walks and tied for third with a .299 average. The Ontario native is hitting .286 in June and has collected at least one hit in five of six games this month.

TJ Time.... Bowling Green sends TJ Nichols to the hill for his second start of the series. He earned the win in the series opener, hurling 5.2 innings while allowing two runs on two solo blasts. The right-hander has scuffled over his last three starts, recording a 6.60 ERA with 17 punchouts to eight walks over that span. In comparison, he compiled a 0.78 ERA with 29 strikeouts to just one free pass over his previous four starts.
